There is not so much drunkenness and homes are in better condition. The house accommodation has not improved at the same time. Most of the people are dependent on the Royal Arsenal for employment, directly or indirectly.

Low Wages in Arsenal The labourers in the Control Department only get 18/- per week for 54 hours or about 4^d per hour. This branch was originally intended to provide em-
 ployment for pensioners.
